
### 1 Amendment

The Road Traffic (Control) Fees Regulation Order No.3 of 2004 is amended as set out in the Schedule.

## **"3A** Advance payment of the prescribed fees under subsection 46A(2)

A holder of a driving licence may make an advance payment of the fee prescribed under subsection 46A(2) for every date on which his or her licence expires, within a 6 year period.

## 3B Advance payment of the prescribed fee under subsection 46B(3)

The holder of an old licence may make an advance payment of the prescribed fee under subsection 46B(3) for every date on which the annual fee is due, within a period 6 years."

# **Discontinuance or Deferral of Industrial Action** Order No. ධුර of 2005

In exercise of the powers I conferred on me by subsections 34(1), (2), and (3) of the Trade Disputes Act [CAP 162]/I, Honourable GEORGE WELLS, Minister for Internal Affairs make the following Order:

#### 1 **Discontinuance of industrial action**

During the period for which the order remains in force, no member of a class of person specified under this order shall call, organise, procure or finance a strike, or any irregular industrial action, or threaten to do so, or institute, carry on, organize, procure of finance a lock-out or threaten to do so:

- (a) The Vanuatu National Workers Union and all its registered members and any member of the general public who has an interest in the issues surrounding the Vanuatu Workers Union and the Vanuatu Abattoir following the failed arbitration process;
- Mr. Ephraim Kalsakau, Secretary General of the Vanuatu National Workers (b) Union, Mr. Sam Mimisa, Advocate, VNWU, Mr. Willie Ova, Union Representative and all other former staff of the Vanuatu Abattoir and their relatives and other registered members of the Vanuatu National Workers Union and the general member of the civil society.

#### Period of effect of this Order 2

This Order shall remain in force from the 23<sup>rd</sup> June 2005 to the 21<sup>st</sup> August 2005.

#### 3 Commencement

This Order commences on the 23<sup>rd</sup> June 2005.
