TAXIS ACT [CAP 49]

Land Transport Board Subsistence Allowance Order No. 25 of 2005

An Order to prescribe allowances to Members of Land Transport Board.

In exercise of the powers conferred on me by Subsection 18(8) of the Taxis Act [CAP 49], I, the Honorable GEORGE WELLS, Minister of Internal Affairs make the following Order.

INTERPRETATION

1. In this Order, unless the context otherwise requires

"Meeting" means a full days meeting or part of a days meeting.

SUBSISTENCE ALLOWANCE

- 2. (1) For the meetings of the Board the maximum subsistence allowance is as follows:
 - a) The Chairman is entitled to VT10.000 for each day or part of a days meeting;
 - b) The Secretary of the Board is entitled to VT9.000 for each day or part of days meeting;
 - c) Members are entitled to VT6.000 for each day or part of a days meeting.



RESERVE BANK OF VANUATU ACT [CAP. 125]

VT 1, 000 25th ANNIVESARY COMMEMORATIVE BANKNOTE

Pursuant to section 19 of the Reserve Bank of Vanuatu Act, Cap 125, the Reserve Bank of Vanuatu wishes to inform members of the public that with effect from the 6th day of July 2005, a 1000 Vatu banknote commemorating the 25 years of Vanuatu's independence anniversary is of legal tender and will co-circulate the existing 1,000 Vatu banknotes. It is important to note the following:

- The VT1000 25th Anniversary Commemorative banknote is a limited printing to celebrate this proud occasion in the history of Vanuatu. The banknote, at a technical level, is a repeat printing of the current circulating VT1000 banknote, but it is distinguished with its addition of another Intaglio printing that depicts the commemorative celebrations. This is shown by a silver jubilee symbol located on the left side of the front of the note, on the watermark. The symbol consist of two ring circles with the words "**25 yia**" positioned in the center of the circles and the words "**silver jubilee**" written around the inner and outer circumference of the circles in English and French languages.
- The second distinguishing feature is the unique numbering of each individual banknote, which carries a special numbering prefix for these celebrations beginning with the roman numeral numbering "XXV". These two features allow the public to recognize this special issue of the VT1000 and allow our country to publicize its achievements in a lasting way.
- Thirdly, it bears the signature of the Minister of Finance & Economic Management, Honorouble Moana Kalosil Carcasses and the Governor of the Reserve Bank of Vanuatu Mr. Odo Tevi.
