LIQUOR LICENSING ACT [CAP 52]

Liquor Licensing (Prohibition of Sale) Order No.16 of 2013

In exercise of the powers conferred on me by section 19 of the Liquor Licensing Act [CAP 52], I, the Honourable TOARA DANIEL KALO, Minister of Internal Affairs, make the following Order.

1 Sale of Liquor Prohibited

The sale of liquor in or from licensed premises through out the provinces of TAFEA, SHEFA, MALAMPA and PENAMA whether for consumption on or off such premises is prohibited from 12 midnight Monday 11 February 2013, to 12 midnight Tuesday 12 February 2013.

2 Exemption

Liquor may be sold during the period referred to clause 1 within the normal hours of the opening in restaurants and hotels to bona fide customers for consumption with food.

3 Commencement

This Order commences on the day on which it is made.

DECENTRALIZATION ACT [CAP 230]

Local Government Councils (Date of Election) Order No. 17 of 2013

In exercise of the powers contained in subsection 18A(4) of the Decentralization Act [CAP 230], the Electoral Commission make the following Order.

1 Date of elections

The date for election of the elected members of each of the following Local Government Councils is 12 February 2013:

- (a) the TAFEA Local Government Council;
- (b) the SHEFA Local Government Council;
- (c) the MALAMPA Local Government Council; and
- (d) the PENAMA Local Government Council.

2 Commencement

This Order commences on the day on which it is made.

POLICE ACT [CAP 105]

Instrument of Appointment of Members – Internal Investigations Order No.18 of 2013

In exercise of the powers conferred on me by subsections 45B (1) and (2) of the Police Act [CAP 105], I, the Honourable SATO KILMAN LIVTUNVANU, Prime Minister, make the following Order.

1 Definition

In this Order unless the contrary intention appears:

"Board" means the Police Review Board established under this Order to carry out internal investigations pursuant to section 45B of the Police Act [CAP 105] (the "Act");

"Minister" means the minister responsible for Police.

2 Appointment of Board members

The following persons are appointed as members of the Board:

- (a) Harold THOMPSON;
- (b) Obed NALAU; and
- (c) Daniel YAHWA.

3 Terms of Reference

 The terms of reference of the Board are as set out in the Schedule of this Order. (2) The Terms of Reference of the Board may be amended or varied by the Minister in consultation with the Board.

4 Location of Internal Investigation

The Internal Investigation is to be made in Port Vila and at such other place or places as the Board may determine.

5 Public or Private Internal Investigation

The Internal Investigation is to be held in public except in circumstances as directed by the Board.

6 Reports

- (1) The Board must prepare a report of its findings and produce it to the Minister with 21 days after the completion of the report.
- (2) The Minister is to provide a copy of the report to the Commissioner of Police within 7 days after receiving such report.

2 Commencement

This Order commences on the day on which it is made.

Clause 1

MALAMPA;

PENAMA."
