

THE IMPORTATION OF INFECTED GOODS ORDINANCE, 1920.

*Western Samoa.—No. 7, 1920.*

AN ORDINANCE

made by the Administrator of the Territory of Western Samoa, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council of that Territory, and in pursuance of the Samoa Constitution Order, 1920.

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Importation of Infected Goods Ordinance, 1920.

2. The Administrator may by notice published in the *Western Samoa Gazette* from time to time prohibit the importation into the Territory of Western Samoa of any goods or materials which are in his opinion likely to convey infectious disease, or stipulate any conditions under which any such goods or materials may be imported, and may by a like notice withdraw any such prohibition or stipulation.

3. When the importation of any goods or materials has been so prohibited the Customs Act, 1913, shall apply to such goods or materials in the same manner as if the importation of such goods or materials had been lawfully prohibited by or in pursuance of section forty-six of that Act.
