AN ORDINANCE

made by the Administrator of the Territory of Western Samoa with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council of that Territory, and in pursuance of the Samoa Act, 1921.

1. This Ordinance may be cited as "The Land for Water Supply Purposes Ordinance, 1935". Short Title

2. In pursuance and exercise of the powers and authorities conferred by Section 271 of the Samoa Act, 1921, and all other powers and authorities thereunto enabling the piece of land described in the Schedule hereto is hereby taken for the purposes of the Vailima Water Supply system and for any other public purpose ancillary thereto.

SCHEDULE.

All those parcels of Native land, situate at Vailima, near Apia, in the District of Tuamasaga, now required for the Water Catchment Area, being parcels 247/24 and 249/26, of Flur VIII, Upolu, containing together 6 acres 1 rood 9 perches (more or less), and shown on Plan 33 U/VIII, S. lodged in the Office of the Chief Surveyor, at Apia.
