## 1994/1995, No. 12

AN ACT to authorise the issue and application of additional sums of money out of the Treasury Fund to certain services of the year ending with the 30th day of June 1995 and to authorise the reduction of certain sums of money previously appropriated for certain services for that year.

[22 November 1994]

BE IT ENACTED by the Legislative Assembly of Western Samoa in Parliament assembled as follows:-

- 1. Short title This Act may be dited as the Supplementary Appropriation Act (No.1) 1994/1995.
- 2. Application Section 3 and the Schedule of this Act relate to the financial period ending with the 30th day of June 1995 (herein referred to the year 1995).
