1994/1995, No. 2

AN ACT to authorise the issue and application of additional sums of money out of the Treasury Fund to certain services of the year ending with the 30th day of June 1994 and to authorise the reduction of certain sums of money previously appropriated for certain services for that year. (28 June 1994)

BE IT ENACTED by the Legislative Assembly of Western Samoa in Parliament assembled as follows:-

- 1. Short Title This Act may be cited as the Supplementary Appropriation Act (No.3) 1993/1994.
- 2. Application Section 3 and the Schedule of this Act relate to the financial period ending with the 30th day of June 1994 (herein referred to the year 1994).

3. Amendment to Appropriation Act 1993/1994- The Appropriation Act 1993/1994 is amended by reducing the appropriations authorised pursuant to that Act by the sum of \$473,038 by effecting the additions and reductions shown in Columns 2 and 3 of the First and Second Parts of the Schedule to this Act.
